Work is the skin of practical living on the skeleton of Scripture.

Ephesians 4:11-12

¹¹ And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers, ¹² to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ.

Our responsibility as workers in a secular world is to live out this scripture of "being equipped for the work of the ministry".

How did the curse affect work? Genesis 3:16-19: thorns and thistles, eat by the sweat of your brow Romans 8:22: Earth groans awaiting freedom from the bondage of corruption that sin brought to the earth



1 Corinthians 12:4-7,11: 4 Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; ⁵ and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord; 6 and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who empowers them all in everyone. 7 To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. ¹¹ All these are empowered by one and the same Spirit, who apportions to each one individually as he wills.

Romans 12:4-5: 4 For as in one body we have many members, and the members do not all have the same function, ⁵ so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another.
