 - e.g. the details and order of details change from one event to another

What's the Point?

Main goal = **SET STAGE** for gospel spread

Other goal = RECOGNIZE THREATS from WITHIN

- → Threat to BODY...
 dividing along cultural lines
- → Threat to MISSION... focusing on physical needs > spiritual needs



Dealing with Drama

Hellenists voiced their complaints to Hebrews

⇒speak up if you're hurting (Matthew 18:15-17, Galatians 6:1-2)

Hebrews didn't argue validity of complaint

⇒be open to correction (Galatians 2:11-14)

Everybody came together & listened to Apostles

⇒stay engaged in / make decisions with the body (Hebrews 10:24-25)





Dealing with Drama

Problem interpreted in light of Church's purpose

→One body, making disciples of all nations (Ephesians 2, Matthew 28)

Leaders were commissioned from within Hellenists

→Encourage different roles/gifts within body (1 Corinthians 12:1-31)

Believers submitted to the Apostles' decision

→Celebrate leadership within your local body (Hebrews 13:17)



Obstacles to Unity

Apathy For Our Mission (e.g. Idolatry)

→What keeps you from going all in for Christ?

Misunderstanding Our Mission (e.g. Bad Theology)

→What part(s) of the gospel do you celebrate? tend to downplay

Apathy For The Body Of Christ (e.g. Selfishness)

→What keeps you from putting others before yourself?

ACTS of the APOSTLES | 6:1-7



So if there is any encouragement in Christ, any comfort from love, any participation in the Spirit, any affection and sympathy, complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind. Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.
