Joy is the internal fulfillment of satisfaction, rest and accomplishment that ONLY comes from following His will.

# WHAT IS THE WILL OF GOD?

### There are two answers to that question.

- 1. A *specific* and defined will can be found often times in the Scripture
  - a. Love God first, love neighbor as self
  - b. Go into all the world, proclaiming gospel to all creation
  - c. If at all possible live at peace with all men
  - d. Slow to anger, slow to speak, quick to listen
    Although these are specific, determining how they
    play out in individuals' lives is a function of the Holy
    Spirit. As individuals, He deals with us in the
    sanctification process like wise.

Do you love His Word? Do you daily dine on it?
Have you set it as a Lamp before you to light your path, then in abundant joy, know that you are already in His will and that the Holy Spirit will guide you constantly as you endeavor to fulfill His will in the unknown areas of your life.

2. An understanding of God's *general* will is something that can be developed as we mature, grow in the natural gifting God has given us, and exercise discernment when specifics are not to be found.

#### I CORINTHIANS 12:4-7

<sup>4</sup> Now there are different gifts, but the same Spirit. <sup>5</sup> There are different ministries, but the same Lord. <sup>6</sup> And there are different activities, but the same God activates each gift in each person. <sup>7</sup> A demonstration of the Spirit is given to each person to produce what is beneficial

#### I CORINTHIANS 12:12

For as the body is one and has *many* parts

#### DETERMINE YOUR GIFTING:

- Live in the known-specific will of God, found in His Word
- 2. Tests, they are not unspiritual, just a tool.
- 3. Others' input, get various perspectives
- 4. Natural bents, where and when you have seen God use you, and where you feel value
- 5. Seek God about their display
- 6. Exercise whenever possible
- 7. Be patient as muscles develop
- 8. Be careful to applaud all gifts, recognizing their need to complete the whole
- 9. Use your brain
