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



LUKE 2:8-14

⁸ And in the same region there were shepherds out in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. ⁹ And an angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were filled with great fear.

¹⁰ And the angel said to them, "Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. ¹¹ For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord."

1st and 2nd Chronicles


Written to **encourage** the post-exile Hebrews in their Godgiven identity.

Shalom as a Tapestry

Tim Keller, Generous Justice

"God created all things to be in a beautiful, harmonious, interdependent, knitted, webbed relationship to one another. Just as rightly related physical elements form a tapestry, so rightly related human beings form a community. This inter-woveness is what the Bible calls shalom, or harmonious peace.... [Shalom] means complete reconciliation, a state of the fullest flourishing in every dimension physical, emotional, social, and spiritual – because all relationships are right, perfect, and filled with joy."

Righteousness

ISAIAH 32:17-18

¹⁷ And the effect of righteousness will be peace,
and the result of righteousness, quietness and trust forever.
¹⁸ My people will abide in a peaceful habitation,
in secure dwellings, and in quiet resting places.



What does righteousness look like?

Bruce Waltke, Understanding Proverbs

"Righteousness' as a social term signifies that people do right by each other...In a nutshell, 'righteousness' means 'to disadvantage oneself as necessary in order to advantage others,' and 'wickedness' means 'to disadvantage others in order to advantage oneself.""



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Emptying ourselves in order to fill others.

Typhoon Haiyan – Philippines

BBC News

Reports marked winds as high as 235 mph. Houses have been flattened by the massive storm surge that accompanied the Typhoon. There's no clean water, no electricity and very little food. City officials said they were struggling to distribute aid and that looting was widespread. In some areas, the dead are being buried in mass graves.







We need **PERSPECTIVE...**

[Gaining Perspective]

C.S. Lewis, *The Weight of Glory*

"If we consider the unblushing promises of reward and the staggering nature of the rewards promised in the Gospels, it would seem that Our Lord finds our desires not too strong, but too weak. We are half-hearted creatures, fooling about with drink and sex and ambition when infinite joy is offered to us, like an ignorant child who wants to go on making mud pies in a slum because he cannot imagine what is meant by the offer of a holiday at the sea. We are far too easily pleased."

[Gaining Perspective]

You're standing in a cold room with no windows, filled with and masked, gloved, whispering individuals swarming around a table.

On that table is an unconscious body, obviously bruised, naked, and injured. The masked persons then proceed to systematically tie down and cut open the defenseless person.

What are you to make of this scene?!



NT Wright, After We Believe

"Imagine a rightful king coming secretly to his people, and gathering a small group of those people to help him overthrow the rulers who wrongfully rule from his throne. When he becomes king, fully and finally, his followers will obviously surrender their whole lives to him as a show of allegiance to their True King.

But when they publicly obey him before the overthrow of the evil rulers – even when the True King is not yet acknowledged – they are genuinely anticipating the obedience they will offer to him in the future."


