The Word

ROMANS 1:16

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God unto salvation

ROMANS 10:14

...how shall they hear without a preacher?

ROMANS 2:4

Or despisest thou the riches of his goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance?

DEUTERONOMY 6:6-9

And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. You shall **teach** them diligently to your children, and shall **talk** of them when you sit in your house, and **when you walk** by the way, and **when you lie down**, and **when you rise**. You shall bind them as a **sign on your hand**, and they **shall be as frontlets between your eyes**. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

CONSISTENCY and **IMPORTANCE**



2 TIMOTHY 2:15

Do you best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, **rightly handling the word of truth**.

 In other words, not flippantly – authority is dangerous when used unwisely

HEBREWS 4:12

For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged word, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joins and marrow, and, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.



HEBREWS 5:12-14

For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the basic principles of the oracles of God. You need milk, not solid food, for everyone who lives on milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, since he is but a child. But sold food is for the mature, for those who have their powers of discernment trained by constant practice to distinguish good from evil.

• The Word, exercised in life, creates a discerner



2 TIMOTHY 3:14-17

But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

My brothers, you also have **died to the law through the body of Christ, so that you may belong to another**, to him who has been raised from the dead, in order that we bear fruit for God.




Wrapping It All Up
