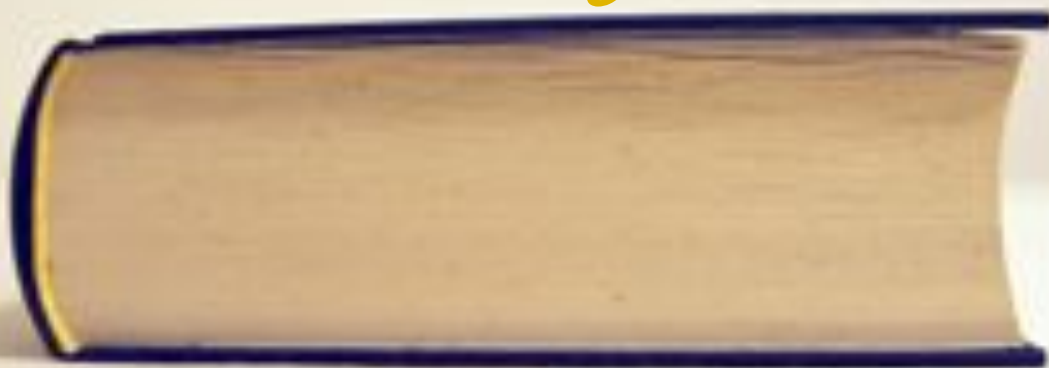

 **Philippians 2:3-8**

Humility

3 Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. 4 Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. 5 Have this mind among yourselves, which is also in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being formed in the likeness of man. And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

Humility

12 Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience, 13 bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.

Philippians 3:12-13

Humility

26 For consider your calling, brothers: not many of you were wise according to worldly standards, not many were powerful, not many were of noble birth. 27 But God chose what is foolish in the world to shame the wise; God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong; 28 God chose what is low and despised in the world, even things that are not, to bring to nothing things that are, 29 So that no human being might boast in the presence of God. 30 And because of him you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, righteousness and sanctification and redemption, 31 So that, as it is written, "Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord."
