INTERNSHIP PROGRAM



MACC Youth

Supports MACC Youth leadership with Bible training, activities, service learning, recruitment, evangelism, and relationship development with youth and their parents. 15-20 hours



B3/Mission Teams

Provides B3 Program Manager with logisticial and managerial leadership support with B3 neighborhood renewal projects, weekly mission teams, and learning seminars. 20-40 hours.



MACC Lit

Provides the MACC Lit Program Manager with pedagogical and logistical support, behavior management, and curriculum design for the third-annual summer day camp. 16-20 hours.



MACC Legal

Provides MACC Legal Program Manager with community organizing, capacity building, partnership development. Assists with Advice and Council days, collaborate with other legal clinics, and build greater community awareness. 10-15 hours.






