Wisdom has built her house; she has set up its seven pillars. She has prepared her meat and mixed her wine; she has also set her table.

Proverbs 9:3

**She has sent out her servants, and she
calls from the highest point of the city,**

Proverbs 9:4

“Let all who are simple come to my house!” To those who have no sense she says.

Proverbs 9:5

**Come, eat my food and drink the wine I
have mixed.**

Proverbs 9:6

Leave your simple ways and you will live; walk in the way of insight."

Proverbs 9:13

Folly is an unruly woman; she is simple and knows nothing.

Proverbs 9:14

She sits at the door of her house, on a seat at the highest point of the city,

Proverbs 9:15

calling out to those who pass by, who go
straight on their way,

Proverbs 9:16

“Let all who are simple come to my house!” To those who have no sense she says,

Proverbs 9:17

“Stolen water is sweet; food eaten in secret is delicious!”

Proverbs 9:18

**But little do they know that the dead
are there, that her guests are deep in the
realm of the dead.**

Mark 4:1

Again Jesus began to teach by the lake. The crowd that gathered around him was so large that he got into a boat and sat in it out on the lake,

Mark 4:1cont.

**while all the people were along the
shore at the water's edge.**

Mark 4:2

He taught them many things by parables, and in his teaching said:

Mark 4:33

With many similar parables Jesus spoke the word to them, as much as they could understand.

Mark 4:34

He did not say anything to them without using a parable. But when he was alone with his own disciples, he explained everything.

Hebrews 1:1

**In the past God spoke to our ancestors
through the prophets at many times
and in various ways,**

Hebrews 1:2

but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom also he made the universe.

Hebrews 1:3

**The Son is the radiance of God's glory
and the exact representation of his
being, sustaining all things by his
powerful word**

Hebrews 1:3cont.

After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven

Hebrews 1:4

So he became as much superior to the angels as the name he has inherited is superior to theirs.

Hebrews 2:1

We must pay the most careful attention, therefore, to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away.

Hebrews 2:2

For since the message spoken through angels was binding, and every violation and disobedience received its just punishment,

Hebrews 2:3

how shall we escape if we ignore so great a salvation? This salvation, which was first announced by the Lord, was confirmed to us by those who heard him.

Hebrews 2:4

God also testified to it by signs, wonders and various miracles, and by gifts of the Holy Spirit distributed according to his will.
