J E S U S

Hebrews 9:15

Therefore he is the mediator of a new covenant, so that those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance,

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 9:15cont.

**since a death has occurred that
redeems them from the transgressions
committed under the first covenant.**

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 9:16

For where a will is involved, the death of the one who made it must be established.

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 9:17

For a will takes effect only at death, since it is not in force as long as the one who made it is alive.

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 9:18

**Therefore not even the first covenant
was inaugurated without blood.**

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 9:19

For when every commandment of the law had been declared by Moses to all the people, he took the blood of calves and goats,

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 9:19cont.

**with water and scarlet wool and hyssop,
and sprinkled both the book itself and
all the people,**

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 9:20

saying, "This is the blood of the covenant that God commanded for you."

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 9:21

And in the same way he sprinkled with the blood both the tent and all the vessels used in worship.

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 9:22

Indeed, under the law almost everything is purified with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins.

Hebrews 9:23

Thus it was necessary for the copies of the heavenly things to be purified with these rites, but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these.

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 9:24

For Christ has entered, not into holy places made with hands, which are copies of the true things,

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 9:24cont.

**but into heaven itself, now to appear in
the presence of God on our behalf.**

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 9:25

Nor was it to offer himself repeatedly, as the high priest enters the holy places every year with blood not his own,

Hebrews 9:26

for then he would have had to suffer repeatedly since the foundation of the world. But as it is,

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 9:26cont.

he has appeared once for all at the end of the ages to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 9:27

And just as it is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment,

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 9:28

so Christ, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time, not to deal with sin but to save those who are eagerly waiting for him.

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 10:1

For since the law has but a shadow of the good things to come instead of the true form of these realities,

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 10:1cont.

it can never, by the same sacrifices that are continually offered every year, make perfect those who draw near.

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 10:2

Otherwise, would they not have ceased to be offered, since the worshipers, having once been cleansed, would no longer have any consciousness of sins?

Hebrews 10:3-4

But in these sacrifices there is a reminder of sins every year. 4For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.

Hebrews 10:5

Consequently, when Christ came into the world, he said, "Sacrifices and offerings you have not desired, but a body have you prepared for me;

Hebrews 10:6-7

in burnt offerings and sin offerings
you have taken no pleasure. 7Then I
said, 'Behold, I have come to do your
will, O God,

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 10:7cont.

**as it is written of me in the scroll of the
book."**

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 10:8

When he said above, "You have neither desired nor taken pleasure in sacrifices and offerings

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 10:8cont.

**and burnt offerings and sin offerings"
(these are offered according to the law)**

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 10:9

then he added, "Behold, I have come to do your will." He does away with the first in order to establish the second.

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 10:10

And by that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 10:11

And every priest stands daily at his service, offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins.

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 10:12

**But when Christ had offered for all time
a single sacrifice for sins, he sat down
at the right hand of God,**

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 10:13

**waiting from that time until his enemies
should be made a footstool for his feet.**

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 10:14

For by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are being sanctified.

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 10:15-16

And the Holy Spirit also bears witness to us; for after saying, 16 "This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days,

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 10:16cont.

**declares the Lord: I will put my laws on
their hearts, and write them on their
minds,"**

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 10:17

**then he adds, "I will remember their sins
and their lawless deeds no more."**

H E B R E W S

Hebrews 10:18

**Where there is forgiveness of these,
there is no longer any offering for sin.**
