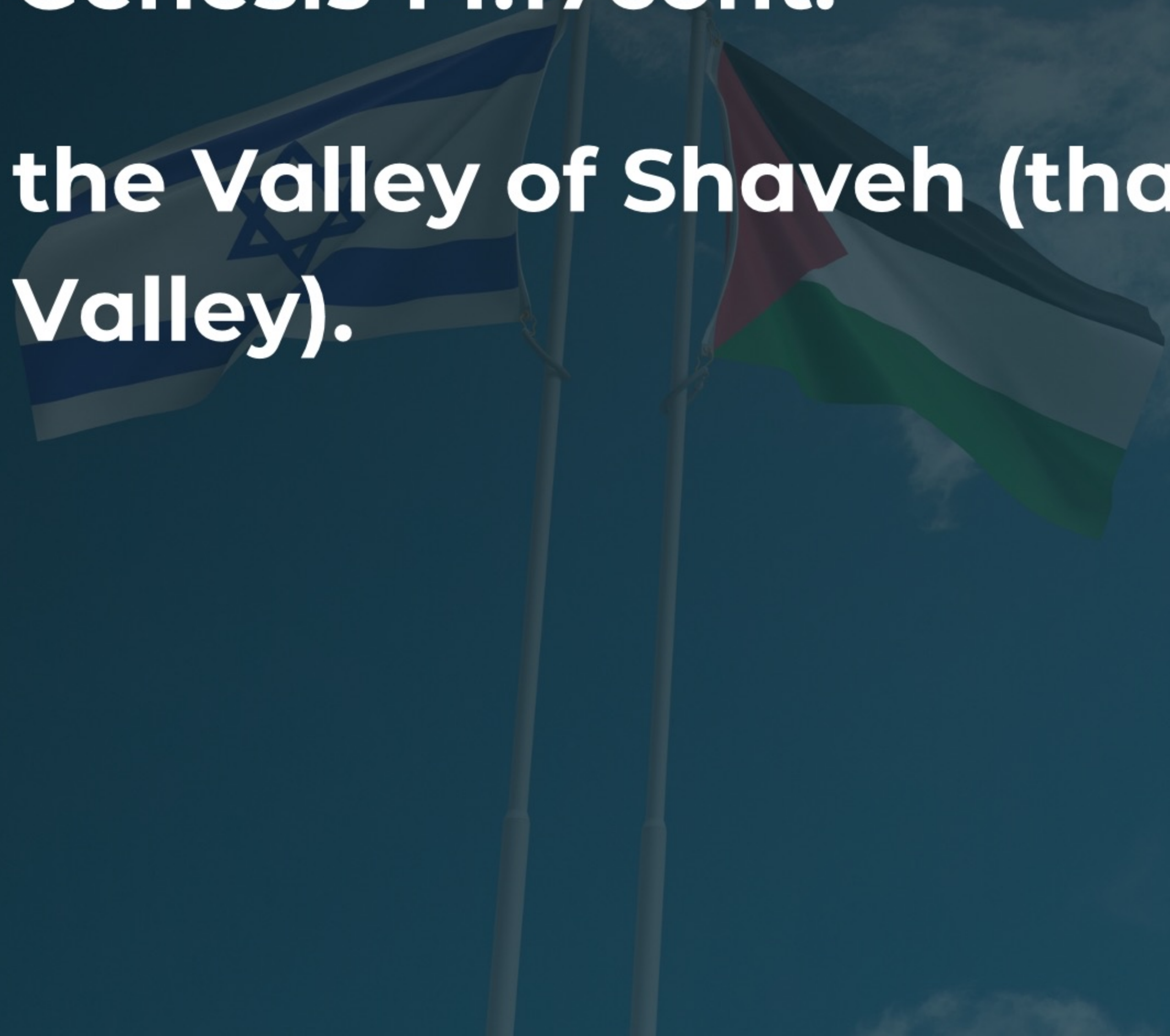






## **Genesis 14:18**
