Our hope in starting a community development corporation (CDC) is to establish ourselves firmly in the process of physical transformation in our community and our city. It is an extension of our church's desire to see all things made new. For us, this physical transformation involves two aspects: community relief and community development.

Community relief means that we will love the marginalized and our city, by providing reprieve in situations of desperate need, such as the loss of a job or a home. Community development means that we will encourage people at all levels toward progress for the benefit of themselves, their family and community.

The long-term vision of starting a CDC is to establish Jesus Christ as the source for true spiritual, physical, and economic growth in Detroit. Our mission is to utilize affordable housing, small business development, and educational initiatives, as a means of providing community members the opportunity to be rooted in Jesus Christ. These three areas, housing, small businesses, and education, comprise our core development strategies.
